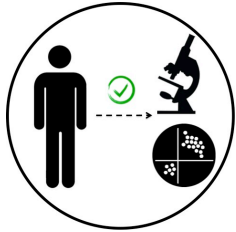

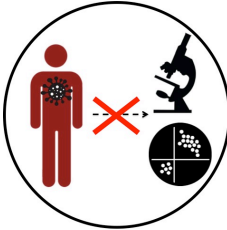
# Preventive Measures in Core Facilities



*From 11<sup>th</sup> of May 2020, instruments in Bioimage and Cell Analytics Facilities can be accessed following additional preventive measures:*



Stay home if you are experiencing **COVID-19 symptoms** or have been in contact with someone displaying symptoms.



Booking has to be done using **Open IRIS**.



**Wash your hands** thoroughly with soap before and after the use of the facility. Wear **new gloves** and **personal lab coat** at all times. **Safety glasses** are recommended.



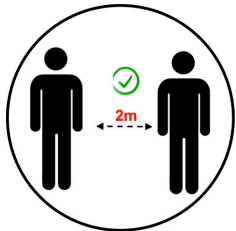
**Wear a face mask** whenever physical distancing is compromised.



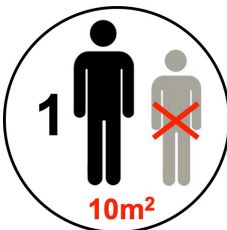
**Disinfect** working surfaces with **70% EtOH** before and after use.



**Trash** cleaning tissues in dedicated waste bins.

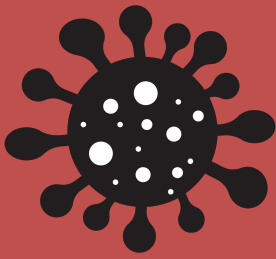


Keep your **distance** of at least **2m** from co-workers. Only **one person** per instrument and per facility room (less than 20m<sup>2</sup>) is authorised.



**Remote support** and assistance is provided. Please contact the facility staff per phone or mail.





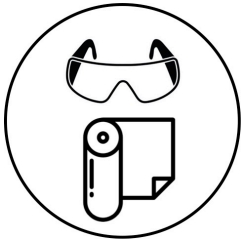

# Preventive Measures in Core Facilities

## Handling of microscopes



Wear **new gloves** in the facility premises and discard them when leaving.



**Wrap oculars** in cling film and remove after use. Alternatively, **wear safety glasses** to look through oculars. **Wear a face mask** whenever physical distancing is compromised.



**Disinfect** working surfaces, mouse and keyboard (when computer is off) with tissues and 70% EtOH before and after use.



**Do not** use EtOH on displays and oculars. Only use lens cleaning tissue for the objectives.

**Trash** cleaning tissues in dedicated waste bins.

**Remote support** and assistance is provided.
