

Adding works using another identifier


Any work using identifiers **DOI** (Crossref, DataCite, and mEDRA), **ArXiv ID** (ArXiv), or **PID** and **PMC** (PubMed ID) can be added.

- Under Works, click on “+ Add Works” and then “Add DOI”.




